New York, NY, May 2, 2015 – **MSG Network and WPIX-TV** were the big winners tonight at the 58th Annual New York Emmy® Awards which took place at the Marriott Marquis' Broadway Ballroom.

Following **MSG Network and WPIX-TV** with 13 Awards each was **YES Network**, which won 12 New York Emmy® Awards.

WNJU Telemundo 47's *Noticiero 47 Telemundo: Tormenta de Nieve* took home the Emmy® for best "Evening Newscast: Larger Markets" for its February 13, 2014 broadcast.

WGRZ-TV took home the Emmy® for best "Evening Newscast: Medium Markets" for its *Channel 2 News Tonight – Blizzard Coverage*.

The **2015 Governors' Award** was presented to **Bob Wolff** for his legendary career as the longest running sportscaster in television and radio history and his incomparable service to the New York region. Presenting the award was **Maury Povich**, the host of *The Maury Show* from NBCUniversal.
