New York, NY, March 19, 2016 – **MSG Network** was the big winner tonight at the 59th Annual New York Emmy® Awards which took place at the Marriott® Marquis’ Broadway Ballroom.

Following **MSG Network** with 14 Awards was **WNBC**, which won 13 New York Emmy® Awards.

WXTV Univision 41’s Eric Garner Protests New York City took home the Emmy® for best “Evening Newscast Larger Markets” for its **December 14, 2014** broadcast.

WRGB took home the Emmy® for best “Evening Newscast Medium Markets” for its **Corruption Crackdown**.

The **2016 Governors’ Award** was presented to **Bill Geist** – Emmy® Award-winning correspondent, “CBS Sunday Morning,” best-selling author, and columnist. Presenting the award was **Rand Morrison**, Emmy® Award-winning Executive Producer of “CBS Sunday Morning.”
